

## **SAFETY**

# **⚠ WARNING**

Be sure to read and follow the assembly instructions before assembling and using the product.


- 1. This product is intended for users ages 9+.
- 2. Maximum user weight is 160 lbs. (72 kg).
- 3. Always wear safety equipment such as helmet, knee pads, and elbow pads.
- 4. Always wear a helmet when using your pogo and keep the chinstrap securely buckled.
- 5. Always wear shoes.
- 6. Use on smooth, paved surfaces away from motor vehicles.
- 7. Avoid sharp bumps, drainage grates, and sudden surface changes.
- 8. Avoid streets and surfaces with water, sand, gravel, dirt, leaves, and other debris. Wet weather impairs traction and visibility.
- 9. Do not use at night.
- Sparking mechanism will get hot from continuous use. Do not touch after using.
- 11. Avoid excessive jumping on downhill environments.
- 12. Adults must assist children in the initial adjustment procedures to use the pogo, adjust or replace the flints in the sparking mechanism, and finally in storing the pogo.
- 13. Obey all local traffic and pedestrian laws and regulations.
- 14. Watch out for pedestrians.
- 15. Check and secure all fasteners before every use.
- 16. Replace worn or broken parts immediately.
- 17. Do not make any modifications to the pogo.



# **SPARKING FLINT REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS**


1. Locate the spring-loaded flint holders in the sparking mechanism.



2. Push the tip toward the center of the pogo and twist the flint holder outwards to release it from the sparking mechanism.



3. With the flint holder out, remove the used flint. Compress the flint spring with your fingers and ensure that it rebounds to the original length. If it stays compressed or becomes deformed, replace as necessary. Insert a new flint into the holder, then the flint spring, then the knob as shown in the diagram. Once everything is fully in the mechanism, push in and then twist inwards to lock the flint holder in place.



4. Repeat steps 1-3 for all other flints that need to be replaced.

#### **MAINTENANCE**

Keep this manual for future reference of assembly and product care. For general safety and maintenance, prior to each use the product should always be inspected for damaged or defective parts including:

- checking all nuts and bolts for tightness and tightening as needed
- checking that all spring-loaded joints are still intact and cannot become dislodged during play
- checking all coverings for any sharp edges and replacing when required
- checking that the grips, footpads, and sparking mechanisms are without defects

## **USING THE POGO**

Your pogo is intended for outdoor use only. It should not be used indoors and is not intended to be used on soft (e.g. grass, dirt, snow, etc.) or inclined surfaces.

### We strongly recommend that:

- the pogo is always used on a level surface
- the pogo is at least 6 ft. (2m) from any structure or obstruction such as furniture, walls, tables, lamps, etc.
- the pogo is not used with or within proximity of other play structures or toys

### For maximum safety and fun, the follow tips below!

- When jumping, stay vertical with your head and body directly over your feet.
- 2. The grips should always be used when jumping for added balance.
- 3. The pogo should not be pulled on, hung on, or used for any stunts or maneuvers.

#### **Return Merchandise for Service**
